Most often, it was the celebration of the birth of Christ by students in public schools and persons in government facilities. Sometimes, the alleged unconstitutional behavior was nothing more than delivering Christmas cards to fellow students. That is clearly protected constitutional speech. Public schools also wished to recognize the many aspects of Christmas, including its Christian beginnings. Those activities were usually prohibited.

On public property manger scenes were prohibited, until the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that if you had other aspects of Christmas present, such as Santa and the Reindeer, that would be alright. We pejoratively call that the "Plastic Reindeer Test".

We are not aware of the extent of Christian activities in public schools and public places during Christmas at the present time. We believe there are probably less of those activities than in days before. On the other hand, we know that through many years of our educational activities and threats of lawsuits, public schools and public authorities began to understand what is permitted.
