Dear Friends and Supporters,

The "State of the Union" is at risk in the upcoming general election. While the Democrats claim Donald Trump is a threat to democracy, it is they who are the threat. The socialist principles advocated during the Biden Administration have done much to change the Union.

Probably the most significant development over the last four years has not been what the Biden Administration has done, but what the U.S. Supreme Court has done under the leadership of originalist Justices. After decades of judicial abuse by Justices, i.e., abortion, same sex marriage, expansion of the administrative state, *etcetera*, the three Justices appointed by Trump have returned the court to its proper role.
